IN-CLASS STANDARDS

Grades are based on proficiency in the Common Core Standards and meeting the Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) — effective communicators, self-directed learners, healthy individuals, critical and creative thinkers, culturally aware individuals, and responsible citizens. Grades are calculated using the point system as follows (subject to change). Participation, as reflected in a student's involvement in class discussions and in class activities, is essential and is accounted. Progress reports will be given every five weeks; however, **current grades can be seen at any time through Infinite Campus Portal**. Keep in mind, **grades are not rounded up**, and when extra credit is available, a student with any zeros in the grade book will not be eligible for extra credit opportunities.
